## *Membership Requirement Point System*

The purpose of this Membership Requirement Point System (MRPS) is designed to allow the Marlinton Fire Department (MFD) to better track the activity of its members. MFD welcomes anybody to apply for membership and always needs new members. MFD provides training, equipment, misc. supplies, and Workers Compensation for all its members. All these items we provide are very expensive to purchase and we constantly must monitor our expenses to ensure we can pay our bills such as insurance, new equipment and truck replacement. We must require our members to be active to justify these items. This system will allow the members that seem to turn out on every fire or accident to be tracked as well as the members that work for the department in the background that are seldom seen by the membership but still provide a much needed service. Each member will be required to accumulate at least 30 points annually to be considered an active member, if a member has less than 30 points, that member's activities will be reviewed by the executive board to determine if they need to be placed on reserve status, equipment returned to the department and or dismissed.

The following activities will be considered as 1 point each time a member participates.

Each member is responsible for logging their information.

Paid staff will log this information onto a database for tracking.
